Description

Each month, the Doody's Core Titles newsletter features an original article written by a librarian or health professional on a topic broadly related to health sciences librarianship or issues of mutual interest to health professionals and librarians. Recent articles have covered topics such as:

Featured Articles are often based on or highlight existing research or publications. The Doody's Core Titles newsletter has a circulation of 6,000 librarians from around the world so publishing a Featured Article is a great way to increase awareness of initiatives, research, and ideas.

Specifications

Featured Articles generally comply with the following specifications:

- Paragraph text written in full sentences that may include sections, bulleted lists, and hyperlinks.
- Graphics, such as charts or screenshots, are welcome.
- Articles average roughly 800 words but may range from 700-1,000 words.
- References or citations may be included in the format preferred by the author(s).
- An Editor's Note may be included to indicate an original publication on which the Featured Article is based.

Submission Process

Final drafts of Featured Articles are due no later than two weeks prior to the anticipated publication date. Iterative drafts are welcome, but not required. Doody's staff will work directly with authors to complete developmental edits at the time of submission. Doody's staff will be responsible for copyediting and final publication formatting. At the time of submission, authors are asked to submit a headshot along with their preferred attribution (name, credentials, and institutional affiliation) as they'd like it to appear with the article.

Publication Process

Featured Articles are published on the second Tuesday of each month as the lead editorial component of the Doody's Core Titles monthly newsletter. The Featured Article will also be the lead editorial piece on the homepage of the Doody's Core Titles website, which is syndicated with the Doody's Review Service website.

In addition, authors may request that the article is published with a Creative Commons license. Unless noted otherwise, the author(s) retains the copyright for the Featured Article. Any requests for reuse or republication not guided by a CC license or directly involving Doody Enterprises' proprietary platforms will be evaluated and decided on at the discretion of the author(s).
